

What to Bring for Your Black Bear Hunt

Equipment:

- 1 pair of easy-on/off camp slippers (with rubber bottoms). We have a boots-off policy in all our buildings & these slippers will make your building-to-building travel easy
- 1 pair of wool pants
- 1 pair of long underwear
- 1 pair of hunting jeans
- several shirts and undershirts
- a good sweater
- a coat or extra sweatshirt for cool evenings
- 1 fresh set of travelling clothes for the trip home
- camo rain suit or poncho
- 1 pair of warm mitts or gloves (water repellent)
- 1 pair of water-proof hunting boots
- extra duffel bag for transporting meat and or trophies
- 1 hat/beanie for cool rides on boats and ATVs
- Personal toiletries, scent free shampoo, toothbrush/paste, shaving kit, etc.
- flashlight/headlamp & replacement batteries
- compact light binoculars (optional)
- medium/large sized backpack (quiet material) for the stand
- insect repellent with high (at least 90%) deet content
- Thermocell (sometimes airlines will not let you travel with butane/accelerant, we will have this available at the lodge)
- a headnet (storable in your pocket)
- light gloves
- sunglasses, sunscreen
- chapstick

Required Hunting clothing/equipment

If you are hunting with a rifle you will need:

- Vest orange, white or red
- Hat orange, white or red

If you are hunting archery:

- All camo

- A soft case for transporting your gun or bow from camp to the hunting area. The vest, hat and case are required by law
- Bring the gun or bow that you shoot the best and get in a lot of practice in the month before your trip.

- ❑ Your rifle should be at least a 270 or larger. You should be capable of a 6 inch group at 100 yards
